Year 12 students wishing for an ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admissions Ranking) will choose 80 credits, equivalent to four full year Stage 2 subjects, or the VET equivalent, from the list overleaf, and must achieve a grade of C- or better in 60 credits at Year 12.

Students wishing to complete SACE only must choose 60 credits from the list overleaf. An additional 20 credits can come from:

- another Year 12 subject
- two (10 credit) Year 11 subjects
- A VET course

### **Year 13 Students:**

Students returning as Year 13 students will work towards completing their SACE Certificate or improving their Australian Tertiary Admissions Ranking (ATAR). Year 13 students must do a minimum of three full-year subjects to continue attending Unley High School.
