All VET programs offered will give the student:

- SACE Credits (each competency will be accredited towards the SACE)
- Nationally Accredited VET units / Qualifications

Student participation can be arranged at times to suit the student and so that it will cause minimal disruption to their school based program. Most courses will all be held off-site. All VET programs involve costs that the student will be responsible for. These can range from \$400-\$1800 depending on the program.
