Personal and Social Identity [PSI]

Students continue with the same PSI group from year 8 in 2023.

Music

Special Interest Programs

Special Interest Rowing

Students in this program undertake Rowing for a full year, in place of their HPE option (indicated in step 4 on the first page). Students in this program continue to undertake Rowing for a full year in Year 9, and for at least 1 semester in Year 10.

Summit STEM

Students in this program undertake Science and Mathematics within the Summit STEM Program. Students continue these subjects for a full year in Year 9 and Year 10.

Summit English/Language

Students in this program undertake English, French Language and HASS within the Summit English/Language Program. Students continue Summit English and Summit French for a full year in Year 10. Students undertake a semester of Summit History in Year 10.

French Bilingual Program

Students in this program undertake Science, Mathematics, HASS and French language within the French Bilingual Program. Students continue these subjects for a full year in Year 10.
