This selection form is a guide for students and parents to discuss their subject selections in the lead up to formal course counselling in term 3. At that time subject choices will be entered during interviews with students and parents in week 6 of term 3. Year 12 students intending to receive an Australian Tertiary Admissions Ranking (ATAR) will choose 80 credits, equivalent to four full-year Stage 2 subjects, or the VET equivalent, from the list on the following page (not including Community Studies). Students must achieve a grade of C- or better in 60 credits at Year 12.

Students intending to complete SACE only must choose 60 credits from the list on the following page. An additional 20 credits can come from:

- another Year 12 subject
- two (10 credit) Year 11 subjects
- a VET course

Students returning as Year 13 students will work towards completing their SACE or improving their ATAR. Year 13 students must do a minimum of three full-year subjects to continue attending Unley High School.
